Josh Eyler is Director of the Center for Excellence in Teaching & Learning and Director of the Quality Enhancement Plan for Critical Thinking in Gen Ed Courses at the University of Mississippi, where he is also Clinical Assistant Professor of Teacher Education. Prior to joining UM, Eyler was the founding director of the Center for Teaching Excellence at Rice University, Associate Director of the teaching center at George Mason University, and a faculty member at Columbus State University, where he was awarded tenure in 2011.

Eyler is the author of the book <u>How Humans Learn: The Science and Stories behind Effective</u> <u>College Teaching</u> (West Virginia University Press, 2018), which was named a "Book of the Year" in the *Chicago Tribune*. His forthcoming book, *Failing Our Future: How Grades Harm Students, and What We Can Do about It* (Johns Hopkins University Press), will be out in August and tackles one of the most urgent issues in education today--grading and alternative assessment.
