

## **Camille Carey**

Camille Carey is the Vice Dean and the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs at the University of New Mexico School of Law. She is a Professor of Law and holds the Karelitz Chair in Evidence and Procedure. Vice Dean Carey joined the UNM Law Faculty in 2009. She teaches Torts, Advanced Torts, and Civil Procedure. She has also taught Domestic Violence and Immigrants' Rights and in the Clinical Law Program. Vice Dean Carey began her teaching career at Yale Law School as a Robert M. Cover Teaching Fellow and Clinical Lecturer. At Yale, she established and taught in the Domestic Violence Clinic. Prior to entering law teaching, Vice Dean Carey was an Equal Justice Works Fellow, Mayer Brown Fellow, and Staff Attorney at The Legal Aid Society of New York in New York City. Vice Dean Carey's research and teaching interests include tort law, domestic violence, feminist legal theory, immigration, and clinical legal education.
