Veronica Thierry Mallett M.D. MMM is the Executive Director for the Center for Women's Health Research a position she has held since March 2020. For the prior three years she served as the Senior Vice President of Health Affairs and Dean at Meharry Medical College School of Medicine (MMC SOM). Born in Detroit, Dr. Mallett attended Barnard College, Columbia University followed by medical school at Michigan State University, College of Human Medicine in East Lansing, Michigan. Following medical school, she completed residency in Obstetrics and Gynecology and Fellowship in Urological Gynecology at Wayne State University in Detroit. She then went on to complete a Research and Surgical Fellowship in Electrophysiology of the Pelvic Floor/Reconstructive Surgery from St. Mary's Hospital, Manchester, England in September 1993. She obtained her master's degree in Medical Management from Carnegie Mellon in Pittsburgh in March 2011.

Since finishing her formative education, Dr. Mallett has served on the Faculty of Northwestern, Wayne State, University of Tennessee Health Science Center, Texas Tech Health Science Center El Paso, holding leadership positions in each of these schools. She has served as Urogynecology Fellowship Director, Residency Director, Director of Healthcare Excellence and Safety, Practice Plan Director and Department Chair both at the University of Tennessee Memphis and Texas Tech. She has been in her role as Dean of MMC SOM just short of three years.

Dr. Mallett has received several leadership and teaching awards. Among the awards she has received recently Nashville Business Journal Women of Influence 2020, Leadership Nashville 2020 Class, and the Nashville Medical News 2018 Woman to Watch. She is a graduate of the Nashville Health Care Council Fellowship Class of 2018. She has invited speaker at numerous national conferences and a board examiner for the American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology.

She has been the recipient a number of research grants awards from the NIH and other funding resources. She had authored close to 100 articles, book chapter and abstracts combined. She has conducted numerous clinical trials and has had a fruitful research career.

Dr. Mallett is a member of a number of professional organizations including the Association of American Medical Colleges Council of Deans Administration Board, American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology, International Continence Society, American Uro-Gynecologic Society, and the International Uro-Gynecology Association where she served on the Finance and Research Committees respectively. In addition, she serves on the Board of Bridges for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing and is a member of the Hendersonville Area Links Inc. She is board certified in both Obstetrics and Gynecology and Female Pelvic Medicine and Reconstructive Pelvic Surgery. She has received international and national recognition for her expertise in the treatment of urinary incontinence and genital organ prolapse, as well as issues critical to health care delivery in underserved communities.

Growing up in Detroit to two parent educators, Dr. Mallett is fluent in medical Spanish. Over the past three years she has been dedicated to leading Meharry Medical College to transformation growth with a new integrated presentation-based curriculum and transforming the clinical enterprise.
